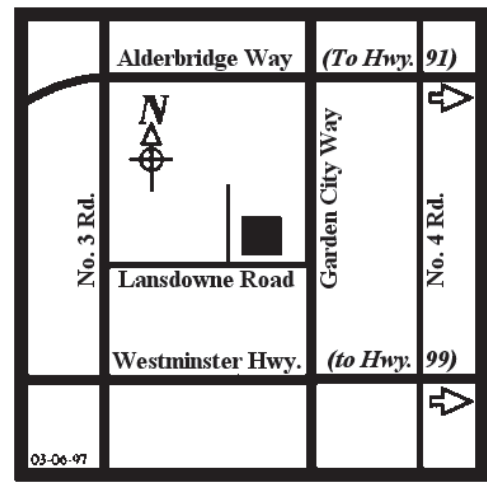

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Course Description:

These seminar based study clubs will explore diagnosis and treatment planning and various fixed prosthodontic options to restore individual teeth and the partially edentulous patients. The topics will include occlusion, materials, and procedures from ceramic veneers to long-span bridges. Each 3 hour session will be broken down into a two-hour seminar and a one-hour case review. Participants will be encouraged to present interesting cases or published papers for discussion with the group. A closing dinner in May is a highlight of this Study Club.

If you have participated in Dr. Wyatt's previous Study Club, Part II, this will be an opportunity to continue.

Clinician:

Chris Wyatt, BSc, DMD, MSc, FRCD(C), Dip Pros, is a Certified Specialist in Prosthodontics and an Associate Professor and Head of the Division of Prosthodontics and Dental Geriatrics at the University of British Columbia, Faculty of Dentistry. He is the 2009 recipient of the W.W. Wood Award for "Excellence in Dental Education." In 1998 Dr. Wyatt was the recipient of the Killam Teaching Award. In addition to lecturing and providing continuing education courses on prosthodontics within and outside of Canada, he enjoys treating patients with prosthodontic concerns in his private practice. Dr. Wyatt is past President of the Association of Prosthodontists of Canada and the BC Society of Prosthodontists, and an associate member of the Pacific Coast Society for Prosthodontics. He is an active member of the Canadian Dental Association, British Columbia Dental Association, and the College of Dental Surgeons of British Columbia.
