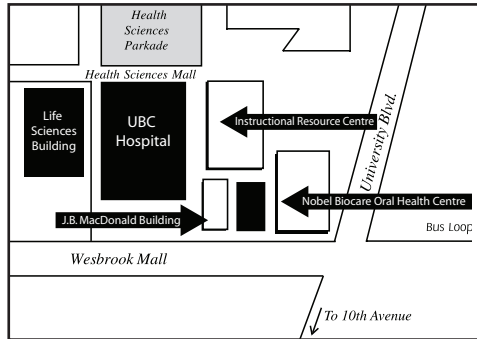

COURSE OUTLINE

This is a limited enrolment clinical participation course, emphasizing examination, treatment recommendations, appliances and esthetics. Lecture and cases will be presented at each session.

Participants will be required to provide patients and certified dental assistants for the hands-on sessions. Course details and a list of required instruments/supplies will be provided upon registration.

Patients are not required for the first session. Dr. Nasedkin will provide information at that time, to assist in determining suitable patients for the clinical sessions.

CLINICIAN

John Nasedkin, DDS, FRCD(C), FADM is one of Vancouver's most experienced workshop teachers and prosthodontic consultant. He is Past President of the American Equilibration Society and a member of several prestigious organizations including the Pacific Coast Society for Prosthodontics and the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry. Dr. Nasedkin is the mentor of the first esthetic study club in Canada and is the co-editor of the book, "Occlusion, The State of the Art". He has taught Occlusion/TMD and esthetics internationally, and was the originator of the "Expocclusion" program presented by Continuing Dental Education at UBC in 2006.

COURSE CONTENT

OBJECTIVES:

- Occlusal and TM Joint examination, differentiation and treatment recommendations. An informed consent letterhead. Impressions for appliances. (Patients not required for this session.)
- Occlusion appliances practical applications. When and how to use bite neutralization. Insertion and initial modifications of stabilization splints. Determinants for use of repositioning or bite raising appliances.
- Occlusal bite refinement to a neuromuscular response. Patient and practice management of bite adjustment.
- Canine risers. Composite and permanent enhancement of lateral guidance to assist bite stabilization. Clinical experience of canine risers
- Occlusal dynamics in esthetics. Determinants for anterior and full-mouth diagnostic wax-ups. When and how to use articulators to assist esthetics. Application of smile design principles.

This course involves 31.5 hours of instruction.
