## COURSE OUTLINE

These courses are designed for the general practitioner to provide clinical knowledge and instruction in periodontal flap (Part A) and/or soft tissue surgery (Part B), using practical and predictable techniques.

Treatment planning with an emphasis on diagnosis, treatment regimens and post operative care will be complimented by case presentations. Indications and contraindications for flap surgery (Part A) and/or soft tissue surgery (Part B), in addition to appropriate case selection, when to refer, proper techniques and wound healing will be covered. Lecture and case presentations will be scheduled for the morning sessions and periodontal surgeries for patients will be scheduled for the afternoon sessions.

Participants are responsible for providing patients for this course, and all potential patients must be pre-approved by Dr. Grisdale. Course details and a list of required instruments/supplies will be provided upon registration.

Upon completion of this course, participants will learn:

- Proper case selection
- Indications for periodontal flap or soft tissue surgery
- Pre-operative and postoperative patient management
- When to refer
- Improving care for the periodontal patient and expand procedures in their practice.
